

## WELCOME TO THE FREMONT VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION

VR provides educational services and other employment related opportunities that are individualized to meet your needs. Our Employment Program can assist you in preparing for, getting and keeping a job. Participation in the Employment Program gives you access to our General Educational Development (GED) Program if you do not have a high school diploma. Participation is voluntary although it may be recommended by your VR Specialist, probation officer or caseworker.

## VOCATIONAL ASSESSMENT, EVALUATION & COUNSELING

Many tools and assessments are available to explore your vocational strengths, interests and abilities. We will help you understand information about job opportunities and employment options that may be right for you.

## CAREER EXPLORATION

We will explore different employment environments and the skills required for each career path.

## THE GED PROGRAM

The GED Program offers an excellent opportunity to earn a State of Nebraska High School Diploma. Employers, colleges, and branches of the military generally accept the GED, and it provides an avenue to achieve most of the goals you may choose.

## GED PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

- Minimum 16 years of age.
- Active participant in VR services.

## YOUR GED PROGRAM RESPONSIBILITIES

- You are expected to abide by the rules for classroom behavior and conduct.
- Most importantly, you should come ready to learn and achieve!



## VOCATIONAL PLANNING

An individualized plan for employment will be developed that meets YOUR needs, interests, and goals.

## JOB PLACEMENT

We can help prepare you for the job application/interview process as well as answer questions such as:

- *How do I prepare and dress for a job interview?*
- *How do I fill out a job application and choose references?*
- *How do I explain any court involvement?*

## JOB RETENTION

- Once you have the job, it is important to know how to keep it!
- Be on time!
- Try your best to get along well with co-workers and customers.
